

Roll-Off Driver

Roll-Off drivers are responsible for servicing customers with the hauling of waste or construction debris to a disposal site. Drivers will deliver, remove and haul roll-off containers to/from customer's sites. This position may require driving in congested and/or confined areas. This position will be required to enter/exit the truck several times per day. Drivers may also be required to climb to hook/unhook containers, move items to smooth the load and to secure tarps. Roll-Off drivers are exposed to extreme weather conditions. The hours and physical demand may vary by route or area. We are dedicated to providing prompt, professional and reliable service.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Perform daily pre-trip and post-trip inspections; complete and submit driver inspection reports at end of each shift.
- Provide prompt and courteous roll-off delivery and removal services to commercial and residential customers.
- Drive roll-off truck in accordance with all local, state and federal regulations and company guidelines.
- Proper tarping of containers to prevent loss of contents inside during transport. May be required to manually tarp containers on occasion.
- Maintain, update and complete driver log sheets to be turned in at the end of each shift.
- Using excellent customer service skills; establishes and maintains effective working relationships with other employees, officials and all members of the general public.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Valid Class B/CDL combination with Air Break Endorsement. Class A preferred.
- Must pass a pre-employment DOT drug screening.
- Must pass the post-employment DOT physical.
- Must obtain a current DOT medical card.
- Must be insurable at all times with company's current insurance carrier.
- Ability to perform physical requirements of the job (including but not limited to; sitting, lifting and pushing up to 50lbs., pulling, reaching, climbing, twisting, crouching, stooping, crawling, kneeling and scraping). Some laboring is required.
- Possess general knowledge of the mechanics of trucks to do minor vehicle maintenance.
- Ability to plan out routes to ensure traveling the most time efficient way
- · Ability to work overtime, weekends and/or holidays
- Ability to work in all weather conditions.
